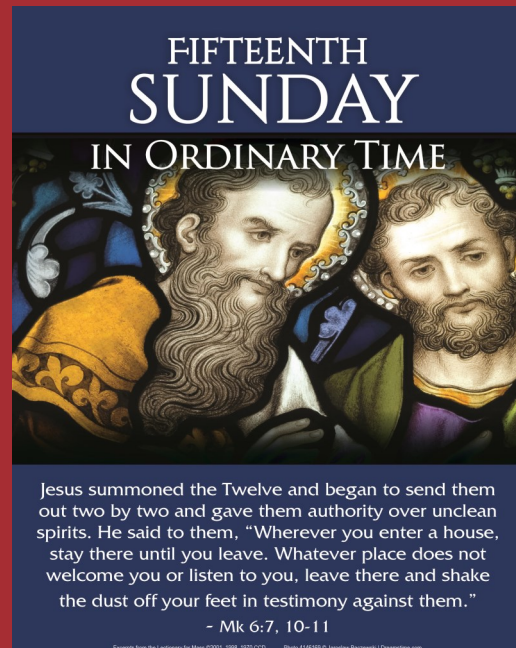

Our **main ministry** consists in providing for the sacramental needs of the people we serve, but we also offer food and clothing. We provide a space for AA meetings to take place, and we offer help with tuition for children to be able to get a Catholic education. Our **simple ministry** of presence has proven over the years to be one of the most important means of support for the people. It allows us to live our gospel way of life and it gives the people a sense of being supported by brothers and priests whom they have come to know over many years of being in relationship.
